EDITAL No 795, de 19/09/2018.

The Director of the Institute of Philosophy and Social Sciences (IFCS), in the use of its attributions and in accordance with the legislation in force program and Resolution CEPG 01/2006), announces the public notice for the selection of foreign candidates not resident in Brazil to the courses *stricto sensu* of Master's and PhD in Philosophy, the Postgraduate Program in Philosophy (PPGF), for the academic year 2019.

#### 1. TARGET PUBLIC

In the selection for the Master Course, foreign candidates who are not resident in Brazil who have completed an undergraduate course recognized by an official teaching institution of the country of origin, whose validity in the country of origin must be duly certified by a consular agency Brazilian In the selection for the Doctoral Course, foreign candidates who are not resident in Brazil who have completed a master's degree or equivalent recognized by an official teaching institution of the country of origin, whose validity in the country of origin may be duly certified by a Brazilian consular agency.

#### 2. REGISTRATION

The registration period will be between October 15 and November 14, 2018. All documentation must be sent to ppgf.ifcs@gmail.com and to: Postgraduate Program in Philosophy. Institute of Philosophy and Social Sciences. UFRJ - Largo de São Francisco de Paula, 1 room 310 - Downtown. CEP 20051-070 - Rio de Janeiro - RJ - Brazil.

Candidates should access the PPGF website (www.ppgf.ifcs.ufrj.br) to, based on the information presented, define the research line in which they intend to develop their thesis / dissertation (which should be indicated in the registration form ) and contact an accredited teacher in the PPGF to indicate as a possible counselor.

## 2.1. DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED

- c) A recent 3x4 photograph;
- d) Copy of the academic record of the undergraduate course;
- e) Copy of the diploma or certificate of completion of graduation course;
- f) Curriculum vitae;
- g) Declaration that you have a guarantee of financial support during your stay in Brazil or that you are applying for a grant in a development agency;
- h) Two letters of recommendation;
- i) Letter of presentation of the application, in which the candidate must indicate the reasons for the master's degree course, the reasons for choosing the PPGF-UFRJ and the research line to which it intends to link, as well as other information it deems relevant to their assessment;
- j) Letter in which the non-Lusophone candidate undertakes to prove proficiency in Portuguese Language in a maximum of 12 months after approval in the program (see item 6 General provisions);
- k) Letter of acceptance from a teacher accredited by the PPGF.
- I) Preliminary research project (up to 5 pages, plus bibliography). The research proposal to be presented by the candidate for the master's degree should include at least the following items:
- 1. Main issue; 2. Justification; 3. Study plan and proposal for the methods to be developed; 4. Bibliography.

# B) FOR APPLICATION TO THE DOCTORAL COURSE

- b) Copy of the passport or other identification document;
- c) A recent 3x4 photograph;
- d) Copy of the diploma or certificate of completion of the master's course;

- e) Copy of the academic record of the master's course;
- f) Diploma or certificate of completion of graduation course;
- g) Copy of the academic record of the undergraduate course;
- h) Curriculum vitae accompanied by supporting documents;
- I) Declaration that you have a guarantee of financial support during your stay in Brazil or that you are applying for a grant in a development agency;
- i) Copy of 01 (one) published scientific article;
- i) Two letters of recommendation;
- k) Letter of presentation of the application, in which the candidate should indicate the reasons for the doctoral course, the reasons for choosing the PPGF-UFRJ and the research line to which it intends to link, as well as other information it deems appropriate relevant to their assessment:
- I) Letter in which the non-lusophone candidate undertakes to prove proficiency in Portuguese in a maximum of 12 months after approval in the program (see item 6 General provisions);
- m) Preliminary research project (up to 5 pages, plus bibliography). The research proposal to be presented by the doctoral candidate should include at least the following items: 1. Main issue; 2. Justification; 3. Study plan and proposal for the methods to be developed; 4. Bibliography.
- n) Letter of acceptance from a teacher accredited by the PPGF;

### 4. NUMBER OF VACANCIES

There is no pre-established number of places for this call for proposals, and the enrollment of the selected candidate is conditioned to the availability of orientation of the faculty of the PPGF-UFRJ.

#### 5. SELECTION

The selection of foreign students not resident in Brazil will be carried out by a selection committee designated by the Graduate Program in Philosophy, based on the documentation submitted by the candidates and criteria defined by said commission.

### 6. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- a) Applicants may obtain information about the PPGF, research lines and faculty at www.ppgf.ifcs.ufrj.br;
- b) Applicants who wish to apply for PEC-PG scholarships should access the electronic addresses http://www.dce.mre.gov.br/PEC/PG/candidatura.html and http://www.capes.gov.br / international / multinational / pec-pg cooperation for more information;
- c) Interested candidates, may request the expediency of the necessary documentation to apply for the PEC-PG scholarship;
- d) The announcement of the final result of the contest will be made through the PPGF Secretariat or by the electronic address www.ppgf.ifcs.ufrj.br, on December 7, 2018
- e) The deadline for lodging an appeal in relation to the disapproval of the candidate will be between 10 and 12/12/2018:
- f) The admission of the student will be conditioned to the availability of guidance by the faculty of the PPGF, as stated in the program's regulations;
- g) The unsuccessful candidate or his / her duly authorized representative may withdraw, at the Academic Secretary of the PPGF, the documentation presented at the time of registration, which

will be available for a period of one month from the date of the final result. discarded. Documentation will not be returned via mail;

- h) PPGF does not offer scholarships for foreign candidates who are not resident in Brazil; the candidate may seek the support of fellowships offered by national and foreign institutions;
- i) The approved candidate must be responsible for travel expenses between the country of origin and Rio de Janeiro and for their maintenance during the course;
- j) The approved candidate must inform the Brazilian consular office of his country about the procedures and documents necessary to obtain a visa to stay in the country during the course. The PPGF undertakes to provide the documents proving its approval in the intended course:
- k) For proof of Portuguese proficiency specified in items 2.1 A and B, the approved candidate must pass the CELPE-BRAS test (information available at
- http://www.dce.mre.gov.br/estrangeiros/celpebras .php or at http://portal.inep.gov.br/celpebras);
- I) Selected candidates must prove English proficiency by means of an official standardized test (TOEFL, IELTS, CPE) or submit to the English Language Examination of the PPGF Masters / Doctorate selection competition, to be held in the same year of their enrollment in the intended course, being evaluated by the same criteria adopted for Brazilian and foreign candidates residing in the country;
- m) The documents requested in item 2.1 A and B (copies of the academic record and the certificate / diploma of undergraduate / masters courses) must be validated in the Brazilian consular service of the candidate's country of origin;
- n) All documents presented at the time of registration that are not in Portuguese, French, Italian, German, Spanish or English must be presented accompanied by a translation made by an accredited / sworn translator.
- o) Letters of presentation may be written in Portuguese, French, Italian, German, Spanish or English.
- p) The preliminary research project and the letters prepared by the candidates (presentation of the application and commitment of proficiency in Portuguese) can be written in Portuguese, French, Italian, German, Spanish or English.
- q) When signing up for the selection process, the candidate acknowledges and accepts the norms established in this announcement;
- r) Omitted cases will be analyzed by the Commission of Selection of Foreign Non-Resident Candidates in Brazil, of the Graduate Program in Philosophy.
